Cooperation is needed for the "body" the church that belongs to Christ to function properly and at its highest efficiency. Ask any person who is no longer able to use a body part, perhaps through disease or amputation, if it is more difficult to perform normal life functions now for them than it used to be.

So, in regards to the body of Christ, what is it that the body needs to function at its utmost capacity?

- The body of Christ needs "tongues" that will teach people who are lost (Acts 5:42; Matthew 28:19-20)
- The body of Christ needs "eyes" that will see the evangelistic opportunities God places before us (John 4:35)
- The body of Christ needs "ears" that will hear the calls from distant shores (and some not so distant) (Acts 16:9-10; Proverbs 21:13)
- The body of Christ needs "hands" that will work, understanding the urgency of the work of the Kingdom (John 9:4; 1 Corinthians 15:58)
- The body of Christ needs "feet" that will go where God needs us (Mark 16:15; Acts 8:26-39)
- The body of Christ needs "backs" that will bear the burdens of others (Galatians 6:2; Romans 15:1-2)
- The body of Christ needs "arms" that will express to others the love of God (1 John 3:9-23; John 13:34-35)
- The body of Christ needs "hearts" that will be concerned about where people are going to spend eternity (Luke 19:41; 2 Corinthians 11:28)
