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# Biblical HACCP – Part 2

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**HACCP - Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Points** - This is a method of assuring to a high level of confidence in our spiritual purity.

You must learn how to remain faithful to God. Remember it is not just about starting the process, it is about finishing as well. A faithful person will be given a crown of life when this life is over (Rev 2:10). So, what are the critical control points of a faithful life after becoming a Christian?

Faithfulness in:

Worship

Prayer

Study & Growth

Purity

Adding the Fruits of the Spirit

Bringing others to Christ

Many other things . . . . .

Jesus told a group of scribes and Pharisees who were hypocrites that they had neglected the weightier matters of the law: justice and mercy and faith (Matt. 23:23). Then He says something astounding, He says, These you ought to have done, without leaving the others undone! What does this mean? There are critical control points that we must keep in mind at all times. These are the “weightier matters,” but the other

things must be followed as well. Did Jesus say, “If you love Me keep *some* of My commandments?” NO! Did He tell the people in Matthew 7 that those who do *some* of the will of My Father in Heaven will enter the kingdom of heaven? NO!

I have some simple questions for each of us to answer:

**F**riends, can you go to heaven without being a child of God? **NO - Critical Control Point.**

**F**riends, can you go to heaven with sin on your soul? **NO - Critical Control Point.**

**F**riends, can you go to heaven without being a compassionate, prayerful, studious child of God? **NO - Critical Control Point.**

**F**riends, can you go to heaven living an impure life of sin and not adding the fruits of the Spirit to your life? **NO - Critical Control Point.**

**F**riends, can you go to heaven while ignoring God’s command to worship Him and bring others to Christ? **NO - Critical Control Point.**
